#### GSPA keynote speaker and new exhibition curator announced

British photographer and photojournalist Martin Parr will help open the upcoming Global SinoPhoto Awards (GSPA)'s exhibition 'Culture Identified', in association with Raymond Legal, to be held at Christie's London from 13 – 31 January 2025.

Martin is best known for his documentary photography and for being an author of over 100 books, including his significant work specifically on China: *The Chinese Photobook: From the 1900s to the Present*. He has made many visits to China, where he has become one of the most loved Western photographers, revered by the large population of Chinese photography lovers.

On confirmation of his participation in opening the exhibition, Martin Parr says, "Photography has an incredible power to reveal the subtle, often overlooked elements of

culture and identity. The Global SinoPhoto Awards' open and inclusive approach brings to light the nuances of Chinese culture worldwide through the eyes of talented photographers, without boundaries in nationality, geography and status. In a world that's increasingly polarised, this initiative allows us to come together through photography, to see each

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other's perspectives with empathy and understanding. I'm delighted to be part of the dialogue on cultural identity and heritage."

In addition, international producer and curator Sebah Chaudhry will curate the 2025 GSPA exhibition entitled 'Culture Identified'. Experienced in working at world-class festivals, projects and events, Sebah will curate about 50 photographs selected from the wide pool of entries from GSPA 2020 – 2024, to present a year of reflection that aligns with the celebration of the Chinese New Year in 2025.

Over the last four years, the Global SinoPhoto Awards have collected thousands of images from hundreds of photographers from more than 40 countries. For the first time, the Awards introduces a People's Award in its fifth landmark year. This special Award will be chosen by visitors to the exhibition at Christie's London and via social media channels.

As well as the principal sponsor Raymond Legal, Blick Rothenberg has also returned this year, continuing its support of the Global SinoPhoto Awards since 2021.
